Scott MacInnes is a leader in the Vancouver Island musical community as a performer, conductor, composer, arranger and clinician. He is the Principal Bass Trombonist with the Vancouver Island Symphony. He has also performed with the Victoria Symphony, a variety of groups ranging from jazz and rock bands to chamber groups such as iTromboni, and Pinnacle Brass Quintet. He is the Artistic Director of the BC Brass Collective and the Meridiem Wind Orchestra. Scott teaches and conducts at the University of Victoria Music Department.
